Sexuality Educator Job Posting

The UU Fellowship of Plattsburgh is seeking an experienced sexuality educator to co-facilitate our dynamic Our Whole Lives (OWL) sexuality education program for youth in grades 7-9. The program will run on Sundays from March through May, and from September through December 2024.

Regardless of experience, the applicant must be able to attend a paid online training from 6-8:30 pm on the following dates: Monday, February 5; Thursday, February 8; Monday, February 12; Thursday, February 15; & Tuesday, February 20; Thursday, February 23 **plus** 10:00 am - 3:00 pm on Saturday, February 24.

Title: Our Whole Lives (OWL) Facilitator

Exemption Status: Non-exempt

Benefits: Paid training period

Reports to: Minister

Work Schedule: Sundays afternoons from approximately 12:30 to 3:30 pm, with additional time during the week for preparation and follow up with families, to a maximum of 5 hours weekly, plus required online training (see dates and times above.)

Compensation: \$20/hour, to a maximum of 5 hours/week.

Anticipated Start Date: Week of January 22, 2024

Overview: In collaboration with staff and volunteers on the Religious Education Team, the OWL Facilitator co-facilitates the OWL program for youth in grades 7-9. Applicants must be a minimum of 21 years old.

This position requires the ability to climb stairs.

Responsibilities:

- Co-facilitate weekly OWL program
- Conduct an information meeting with parents, and follow up with parents or respond to their queries, as needed
- Maintain attendance records
- Ensure all materials are prepared and ready for each weekly session



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- Recognize problems as they emerge; report and consult appropriately
- Adhere to the UUFP's Safe Congregations policy as well as to state laws regarding mandatory reporting
- Meet regularly with co-facilitator, RE Team, and Supervisor

Requirements:

- Experience working with youth in an educational or recreational capacity, or certification as a sexuality educator, or comparable experience
- Values in harmony with the program; comfort with your own sexuality
- Excellent knowledge of the target age group's developmental needs
- Ability to convey warmth while maintaining appropriate boundaries
- Demonstrated skills working with youth from diverse backgrounds and with different gender identities and sexual orientations
- Ability to support relationships of respect, reciprocity and responsibility, with and among youth, and with their parents
- Ability to uphold and promote Unitarian Universalist principles and values, and to communicate them as needed
